Introduction

What do I want to be when I grow up? This childhood question is now being considered by people from fifteen to fifty. The number of jobs available is not the main problem. The difficulties come from two areas: first, the vocational possibilities are rapidly changing. Second, many of us are considering our second or even third career because our original choice is becoming obsolete, or makes demands upon us that we could not have anticipated, or is losing prestige, or no longer pays well enough, or has become so mechanized as to bore us to automated tears. In short, we want more.

This report describes your vocational aptitudes from the astrological perspective so that they can be matched in the career marketplace. While the jobs themselves are ever-changing, personality is founded on a solid base upon which to pivot. Self-understanding can supply the physical, emotional, mental and spiritual clues to your best line of work. Then you can determine how to apply your strongest capabilities to the career field you find most attractive.

The best career is one that allows you to use your natural talents and skills. Astrologers use a number of considerations to determine the energies that are strongest and most beneficial in your chart, identifying the type of activities that will be most likely to achieve career success. Sometimes your latent abilities will require training to develop into appropriate occupational skills. Also, you may have talents that serve your avocation - your hobby - better than your career. In this report we will consider a number of possibilities so you can get a sense of which talents are most beneficial in terms of career, and how to develop and use them.

Your Ascendant or Rising Sign

Let's begin with a description of your Ascendant or rising sign. Here you find your natural expression in the world - the way you present yourself to the world and the way others see you.

You can do well in just about any profession you choose. Your naturally expansive personality grows to accommodate career developments and your philosophical attitude allows you to sift out the day-to-day problems from the long term cycles. You can over-extend yourself and dissipate your well-earned position if you lose your ability to survey the larger picture. One of your chief abilities in career is to maintain perspective when other people are losing theirs. Whereas you are not moderate by nature, you are generally honorable. You can avoid excess by maintaining a dignified appearance. You depend on your congenial personality to get you ahead, and you appeal to a higher class of clientele, both financially and socially. You learn the social rules specific to a new situation very quickly. Your popularity comes from the fact that you can fit into just about any crowd. Good careers choices include legal, religious or other professional positions, as well as the banking industry and working with or for wealthy persons. You have a suave demeanor and the mind to match. Your optimism gets you through the necessary training period.

Now take these initial impressions forward with you as you read the rest of this report. You

will come to see if and how these general characteristics fit into the overall picture of your vocational possibilities. As you read, you may find apparent contradictions. This happens because we are complex beings with many interests and abilities. This report presents some of your many choices along the path to vocational success and satisfaction.

Your Creative Touch

Human creativity falls into three principal arenas: creation (the making of things), recreation (the entertaining side of life), and procreation (the creation of the future). Everyone actively engages in all three creative processes, and we often confuse the feelings of one for another. The term "recreational sex" captures the sense of confusion. Some of us work really hard to get "good sex". Some of us feel sex serves only one purpose, that of procreation. Some of us find the deepest spiritual meaning of life in sexual union. To confuse such deeply meaningful matters with mere recreation can be a problem. In terms of career, creativity plays a big role, but typically sexual involvement in the workplace only serves to establish barriers to the free flow of ideas. To gain better understanding of the inner creative urge in its multiplicity of expression is to gain a leg up on the career issues that can lead us to money and fame without also finding inner satisfaction in the work itself.

You invigorate the creative process by sensing the form a project may take and fostering the development of that form. You strengthen the creative ambiance by consolidating the resources needed, providing creative structure to the growth process, and persevering when others may falter. You thrive on the comfortable knowledge that growth continues even when not much can be seen on the surface. You take the greatest pleasure in surpassing the painful moments of doubt and seeing activities through to a more comfortable outcome. "We did it," can become your mantra.

You may find that at some point your creative focus is modified to include a somewhat different mode of expression that has the following characteristics:

Your creativity lies in the ability to diversify an idea. You could have been the original fractal designer, taking one idea and working it into many. You thrive on sharing creative process with others, and brainstorming is your forte. You have the capacity to take a broad view of things, not becoming overly attached to details. When you come back down to earth, you bring with you the sense of space in which to implement your ideas. Your greatest pleasure lies in sharing your experience, and you work well in situations where teamwork is encouraged.

Many people find that the creative urge seeks to apply itself in a particular area of life that may have very little to do with career. By the same token, the creative voice can dictate the path of vocation, if it is either strong enough or consistent with the overall vocational choices. It helps to understand what part of the creative process most pleases you, what feelings and activities you consider to be most creative.

Your mental creativity is a career asset for sure. Generally open-minded, you are also able to speak your mind. You can be a valuable mediator in difficult situations. Avoid the appearance of

superficiality in your work or your speech.

It also helps to be aware of how you can use your creativity to the best advantage.

You need a designated area where you can stash your personal belongings, situate yourself, and dig into the work. You may find that you like an office with a door to leave open - or to be closed when you choose.

Who do you most like to play with when you are being creative? You may think this an odd question where career is concerned, but it strikes at the heart of the career game. If you surround yourself with people who share your creative interests, you will fulfill your inner urge more directly and completely. Just as children work hard at their games, you can play hard at work and thus enjoy this part of your life that takes up the bulk of your waking hours.

Your creative direction can use your adaptability and your analytical skills in an original process or product. You have precision skills. You are also resourceful, utilizing what is at hand to create the desired effect. You are capable of working with children because of your flexible educational style. Details stimulate your mind, so accountants, bookkeepers, educators, engineers, handwriting experts are all people you may enjoy. You also can be at your creative best with advisors, agents, announcers, artisans, attorneys, broadcasters, clerks, computer programmers, whose work focuses on a multitude of information. Service professions such as gas station employees, governesses, inspectors, and teachers stimulate you to creative achievement as well. Add careers involving finesse, such as locksmiths, jugglers and ambassadors.

You have a capacity for common sense, as you understand physical reality and know how to work with it. You can be somewhat rigid and inflexible, yet you know that you are right in many cases. Too much talking can lead to hoarseness of voice. Logical thinking is a tremendous career asset.

You focus your actions on creative potential. You will expend energy in the direction of creation, procreation and/or recreation. Your self-confidence grows as you enter into any creative activity and you are able to express your impulsive nature constructively through creative ideas and activities. There is often a strong sexual desire. Movement is the name of your creative game, and the players will be movers too. You could be around acrobats, athletes, masseurs, firemen, steel workers - anyone whose job is physically active. People who use tools and weapons, such as soldiers, gangsters, hunters, and guards may get you going. You could run an army or perhaps supply it. You could work with doctors or pharmaceuticals as well. To be creative you have to be actively doing.

You have tremendous endurance and would be good at athletics or other careers that require this kind of personal effort. Your abilities have practical application - you may need to figure out what that application is in order to enjoy a fully satisfying career. Your stubbornness is not your greatest career asset, but it can come in handy if you use it only when you truly must have your way. For the most part your reliability and consistency are traits that take you far in the work place.

You can develop a sense of the importance of creativity to your work, and also what factors affect your creative expression, by considering how you seek creative interplay with others and

with the world.

Your inner sense of beauty can become a source of tension when you find yourself in excessively indulgent situations. When you are attracted to another individual, use your own physical and mental tension to attract them. The constructive qualities of firmness, modesty and determination develop only after awareness gained through difficult struggles and delicate health. You live in a psychically open state of mind and therefore you experience the world directly and immediately. Sometimes this comes across as weakness. You can be easily influenced by the glamour of a situation. You have both the positive and less constructive qualities of leadership at your disposal. Dealings with others focus on power issues and make you aware of your own power.

The typical results of your creative forays have the following characteristics:

Thinking and feeling are aligned for you. You have the natural ease of mental process which allows you to learn easily and to express what you have learned in turn. You may be a skilled test-taker. You are a good teacher. You experience passionate relationships because of your ability to moderate between Self and Other. You have a warm heart and creative abilities. There can be fluctuating feelings or a lack of tact. You suffer from a periodic lack of energy and are susceptible to infections. You have an innate sense of timing. You are inspired to acts of devotion. Avoid unnecessary use of drugs.

You have both the possibility of relationship conflicts and the potential for harmonious long-term relationships, depending on how freely energy flows between you and your partner. You fall in and out of love easily. In fact you cast yourself as a principal player in love dramas. Your actions sometimes appear eccentric to others. The exertion of power in love relationships can be intensely satisfying. Relationships can place a great strain on your sexual expression. You sometimes have odd desires.

Current shifts in your creative pattern may be indications of a refinement of your activities to suit the daemon or inner voice. Your awareness of that voice is subject to changes that can have sweeping effects on your career path.

Recent Influences

You seem to know what is coming, with a certainty that defies logic. Thus you can make advance plans. Your emotional eagerness can cause you to tax your physical system at this time.

Current and Future Trends for the Coming Year

Any creative projects you have been working on can benefit from your awareness of subtle changes that promise success.

The communication traffic around you is disturbing. Success depends, just now, on your ability to apply forceful effort while resisting the urge to act too quickly.

Creativity and Career

You may be wondering how creativity affects your career. Perhaps you don't feel that the work you do is very creative, or perhaps you have creative pursuits that are not part of how you earn money. Creativity is the expression of an ideal that we each find within ourselves. We each

have a unique inner essence that deserves to be polished and re-fined in our individual ways. This essence can be expressed through vocation, and indeed it is a force that pushes us toward the most fulfilling career fields. Many factors combine to produce the best vocational choice. Multiple abilities may combine in a profession not usually associated with the individual qualities you possess.

Where You Have the Best Advantage

In the world of vocation certain energies work to your best advantage.

The power of intellect expresses creatively through the positive, unloosened mind. First, you find the creative ability to be aware of what is hidden. Your mind allows you to experience the revelation of unconscious energies and submerged psychic structures. Creative objectivity permits you to balance your perceptions with thought. The creative force of social action will continue beyond individual lifetimes. Finally, you are able to creatively project an ideal into form through intellectual processes. A key word for your creative process is TO MAKE KNOWN. You may tend toward the following capacities where vocation is concerned: intense perceptual abilities, ability to concentrate and meditate, ability to think clearly, ability to put things in the proper perspective and ability to reason, ability to adjust. At best you are able to think without living entirely in your head and to test the water by dabbling before focusing too narrowly on one activity.

These may not be your greatest strengths, yet they work better for you in the work environment, they help you to achieve greater career success and fame, and they may even be essential for financial remuneration. For some people, the things that work where vocation is concerned are very different from what work in relationships or other areas of life.

Your Most Likely Mode of Expression

You may be seen as the steamroller type. This combination is quite productive, as seen in the transformation of clay into pottery or dough into bread. Initiative and practicality are combined to generate sustained powerful energy. You may experience swings between pride and humility, or between generosity and conservatism. Sometimes you come across as insensitive and careless. You have the ability to conserve and direct personal energy.

You are able to adapt to conditions as they arise, learning how to manage and attend to details. You can take on the role of mediator, as you can entertain more than one viewpoint. You can be indecisive. You are also dependable in your work, capable of persisting through to completion with assigned tasks. You are able to recall details and accumulate the information you need for your work. You can be rather stubborn. You may decline to take the initiative in any situation, choosing to let someone else be in charge. You need a boost to gather momentum for projects, and are willing to wait patiently for a push from a source outside yourself.

How You Work Best

Each of us has to work within the framework of our personal traits and habits. Life is not so much about changing those habits as it is about choosing to emphasize one set of behaviors over another. Through this process character is revealed. If we changed our behaviors all the time, we would never settle into the strength of character that we need. Generally, when we desire to change ourselves, we aim to change how we understand and work with our inner being, how we

can come to accept that being. This section of the report considers how you operate in the world, and thus how you tend to function in the work environment.

Your Strongest Psychological Tendency

The Sun is indicative of your primary psychological type. Psychology and astrology both suggest that each individual has a basic style in interacting with the world. The Sun sign indicates the more conscious portion of your style. Individuals do not necessarily conform to this in their outer expression, but it nevertheless is consistent with the underlying approach to life. With the Sun in Taurus, you are primarily the Sensation type.

Sensation types are primarily interested in practical considerations of the world. They will look at the actualities - facts first. They depend on their five normal senses for perception. They wish to have the experience, not hear about it from others. Sensation types learn by doing, so the learning process may be slower. To be satisfied, they need to go over things carefully. They are not less intelligent because they go slower - they are more careful. When given the time to assimilate information, the sensation type may remember it longer and understand the practical uses in more detail. Studying the theory of engineering may be difficult for the sensation type, but the application is their forte. You demand satisfaction all along the way, and will not select occupations that are without positive feedback. You are a healthy consumer, loving life and what it has to offer on the material level and you are best in careers involving real "stuff". You would be a good real estate person, interior decorator, or chef. You enjoy working with your hands and can make this part of the vocation or at least an avocation. You would be a good doctor or health care professional. Any career that requires attention to and intimate understanding of the details is suited to the sensation type.

Your Unconscious Interactive Style

The Moon indicates the less conscious component of your interactive style. It shows what skills and talents can be brought to bear when your usual approach is not effective, and as such it indicates your own internal support system. With the Moon in Virgo, your secondary function is the Sensation type.

The Sun and Moon work together in your chart in a functioning partnership. The more aware you become of the styles you have, the more you can use them effectively. Your conscious individuality and less conscious interactive style work very well together, and this can be an advantage or disadvantage in the work place. As a child you may have been stubborn in your determination to do and to be whatever you wanted, but that trait develops into a solid reasonable nature with great power. Able to accept responsibility, your inner personal beliefs are readily made available to your peers. Your insight into people comes from this capacity to not merely talk the talk, but to also walk the walk. If you expect it from associates, then you demonstrate it yourself. You seldom expect subordinates to do any work that you would not willingly do yourself. You impress others with your insights into the realities of work situations. You respect authority and expect others to accept your use of it. Loyalty is important to you - you are, however, loyal to your own principles first. You can be somewhat sentimental. You seek powerful intellect in others, just as you seek to develop your own. Any perceived handicap from childhood pushes you even harder to achieve success as an adult. To a certain extent, the exercise of your power is more important than the accumulation of material wealth. Self-control is a must

for you. You can be cold, resisting close ties that could limit your ambitions.

What You Show the World and What You Know About Yourself

If you are aware of how other people see you, you have a distinct career advantage. Such awareness provides a tremendous opportunity to present yourself in the best light possible. You may have a rather different persona in the work place than you have anywhere else because different traits are expected by your co-workers. You therefore can choose to display those personality characteristics that suit your work situation the best.

Your natural direction where individuality is concerned is to proceed on a practical basis, working within a tested, stable framework of order and method. Your focus is on reality.

You support your natural intuitive understanding with a sensitivity to the facts as they present themselves. You are generally firm in your position and consistent in your work. You have a sense of duty which makes you a reliable employee or co-worker.

Your personality naturally tends to exhibit restless energy, together with self-confidence and enthusiasm. You expect to find a place in your career and to hold it. You desire recognition and may sometimes seem self-absorbed. Your sociability is a career strength.

The quality you most easily recognize in yourself is your capacity for harmonious interaction with others. You desire cooperative spirit in others, and you expect support from them just as you offer it. You inspire team spirit rather than employer/employee relationships. You may become impatient with lapses on the part of co-workers, as you expect consistency. You are aware of your social position, yet establish friendships with all kinds of people. You can be pleasant only for effect, and may be viewed as insincere. You may resist going into a battle, but have the skills to emerge a winner. You respond to crises by seeking the path toward renewed balance while synthesizing a solution quickly.

Sometimes it seems that other people understand you better than you do. As you become more self-aware through experience and self-investigation, you see the connections between feelings, situations and events more clearly. You thus are better able to make creative choices in response to life's slings and arrows, instead of reacting from a less conscious drive.

Individual Strengths Being Developed at This Time

As you travel life's path, the balance of your attention changes. These shifts allow you to experience the world in different ways for a period of time, and thereby to develop new skills. The periodic shifts provide what you need to gain perspective if you are to take advantage of learning opportunities as they are presented. These shifts may call for career changes as well.

At this time you have the potential to grow through patient considerations of how factors in the environment are likely to evolve. By considering the practical outcome, you give yourself another way to evaluate problems and deal with them.

For the next few months, your thought processes are stimulated. You are able to learn to apply logic to whatever situation you encounter, and you take a somewhat businesslike attitude to everything in your life.

During the current period you have more feelings of security and practicality. There is a

reserve, even caution, in your career decisions. You tend to be thorough in your work. Purposefulness shows in your actions. Egotism and a desire for pleasure can sometimes interfere with otherwise sound work practices.

The qualities you stand to gain at this time are ambition and ruthlessness. The better you know these, the better you can manage them. You persevere to the edge of doom if necessary and beyond. You know that you need time and space in which to revive from such ventures. You understand the basics of life and therefore can be quite sympathetic toward the problems of others. You know that you will survive just about anything that is thrown your way. You know your own desires and how to fulfill them. You may occasionally overestimate your energy and need to know your limits. You meet resistance in almost everything you do - be sure not to project this onto others, it is your own consciousness that resists loss and change. You can be inspired in emergencies and you have the courage to do what is necessary, even though it may seem cruel at the time.

How You Relate to the World in General

Many factors add up to the sum total of your presence in the world. Some character traits are quite stable, changing very little throughout your life. They are the "mind set" with which you approach all your activities and as such have a strong impact on your career. This section of your report considers how these persistent qualities affect you in your career endeavors.

Psychologists use the terms introversion and extraversion to describe two general ways of approaching the world. These tendencies are rather obvious to others, yet you may not recognize them in yourself.

You have a balanced view of the world, sometimes considering your internal values and sometimes responding to events and people outside yourself. You have moments when you are at one extreme or the other, but for the most part you are near the gyroscopic center, neither deeply introverted nor very extraverted. You experience life more like the gentle waves on a lakeshore - there is movement, but no tidal wave and not much undertow either. Consciousness, for you, incorporates self and other in a blend of considerations.

Another pair of differences fall on a continuum between very self-directed and self-motivated to more responsive or reactive to other people and outside forces.

You live in a world of balanced considerations between what you desire to accomplish for yourself and how you respond to the needs and desires of others. You exercise the initiative when that seems appropriate. At other times you go along with the plan, even though it is not your plan. Cooperative efforts appeal to you, but you are equally able to take independent action. This combination of strengths is beneficial in the career world, as you can roll with the punches, working alone or with others, without discomfort either way.

These two tendencies combine to produce a personal approach to the world.

You tend to respond to others, at home, in personal relationships and in the work environment. Your fundamental beliefs were learned largely through family in childhood, and they may change only after significant thought. Your attitudes toward all objects of personal love, such as mate, child, pet, or friend revolve around responding to them. You usually choose to respond to the needs of others in the work environment, and your attitude toward peers and

subordinates is focused as much on their needs as on the work demands. Your role in the world focuses on how you exercise authority and earn respect. As a general rule you are comfortable in non-intimate situations with friends and groups and you are able to set objectives for yourself and others. There may be profound interest in your inner, private life as well. You are interested in the working of your sub-conscious mind, and value time spent alone. You are able to work in seclusion.

A third consideration is how your mind functions. How you assimilate information and then put that information to use in the outer world can have a huge impact on your career success. It influences not only the career choice itself, but also the area you choose within the career.

You are an eager beaver type, a person who is always into the next activity ahead of everyone else. Yet you need someone to precede you, to wave your flag, so to speak. You sometimes feel as though you have arrived at your destination before you sent the telegram saying you were coming. The slower pace of communication helps you to moderate your thinking.

Summary

Thus far this report has revealed traits of your personality which you may be more or less familiar with. Most people identify with one or more parts of their personality. You may not see yourself exactly as described here, and you certainly will want to consider the qualities that are entering your awareness now, as they are the fuel for future personality developments, and possibly for career advancement as well.

Your Vocational Indicators

Each of us has a natural inclination to function a particular way, and these tendencies become pronounced in vocational activities. We carry our personal desires across a personal boundary into the social milieu and find greater or lesser resistance to our desires there. Yet we may stubbornly press on, attempting to bend the world to our personal desires. We tend to hold on to the old form, even if it no longer serves us. "Better the devil you know" is itself a timeworn maxim.

If, instead of insisting, we learn from social feedback and adapt our approach to the world, we find that life is gentler and career more satisfying. Your personal emotional bias, how you concentrate your talents, and how you best learn from experience all impact vocation in spite of any desires to the contrary. There are several fundamental qualities that bear on vocation, and the following paragraphs consider these factors.

The focus is on your melancholy or emotional struggle. You fret over your work, much as you fret over other areas of your life. Your best work is done in a serious environment, and you may not participate in the office pranks or silliness. While you are off in your laboratory working away, you are also working with your emotions in the back of your mind. Avoid job situations where your feelings are put on display. You have the ability to concentrate on your research

abilities and emotional endurance to see you through the long haul. Keep this in mind in every area of endeavor, not just vocation. You learn from deep research and metaphysical experiences.

There is one area of life where your hard work will achieve the best results. Because of this, you may be steered in a direction that you cannot easily perceive from within the confines of past experience. You need to look beyond past experience and desires into the larger context of your life to find the best place for your efforts. Most people expect a career to provide status, money, and other satisfactions. The type of work indicated here may seem odd, but deserves consideration nonetheless, as it may deliver long term rewards that you cannot perceive at the outset.

The personal asset you need to develop for career success is restraint - the ability to moderate your talents, skills, desires and arrogance. You can start just about anywhere and rise quickly. Executive positions are good from the get go. You will need to take stock from time to time and consolidate your position before you make any big moves. Your natural understanding of the way things work leads you to withdraw or retire while you are at the height of your power.

Current Direction

You now have the personal opportunity to produce new ideas. There has been a gestation period that is now ready for the birthing process. Look for situations that contain promise and pursue them, as they will not pursue you.

You may also consider the area of your life in which these impulses can best be applied, and the focus that will gain the most positive results.

This is a time to focus on your education. We can always learn new things, but now you have the possibility to slug through a difficult learning period to gain a deeper understanding of your work and how it fits into your larger mission in life. As you focus on your connections to the world around you, you will also define the part of yourself that you wish to present to that world.

You can put your attention to details at this time, analyzing what is best for you and also what will make other people more self-sufficient. Avoid the tendency to nag about every little point. It is also important to see how the pieces fit into the larger picture.

All of these considerations come together into a package of skills, decisions, and goals combined with your current potential. The sum total is a description of your ability to learn from experience. If you are well placed in a career field, emotionally suited to the demands of the actual job, and oriented clearly to your goals, you will be successful.

How to Apply Your Energy to the Career

Having looked at how a solid foundation may be established, we now turn to the application of your personal energy to the goal of fulfilling your dreams. The previous paragraphs suggest the most natural form or structure of your career, while the following shows how you pursue it. How do you apply yourself? What drives you? How far can you go? These questions are all answered by your personal energy and how it can work with your natural abilities.

You have abundant energy that in early life may be directed to gambling and speculation, selfish activities and undirected passion. The vocational direction will suffer from these unless or until re-direction of energy is achieved. You develop an enterprising spirit from the gambling

urge, along with a certain fearlessness. The selfish quality becomes self-confidence and self-possession. Your passion is channeled into zeal for your work (at least while you are at work). You develop a sense of responsibility in the process which can make you a good supervisor and leader.

You have tremendous endurance and would be good at athletics or other careers that require this kind of personal effort. Your abilities have practical application - you may need to figure out what that application is in order to enjoy a fully satisfying career. Your stubbornness is not your greatest career asset, but it can come in handy if you use it only when you truly must have your way. For the most part your reliability and consistency are traits that take you far in the work place.

Early in life energy almost seems to use you, as you have little control over desires. Throughout your life you learn to moderate desires of the moment with longer term plans, and you adapt to the environment of parental control, school requirements, peer pressure, marriage or relationship responsibilities, etc. Energy becomes, instead of its own director, an agent for your use, being guided by your will. Your Career Success

Since no one is always nice, after a while you can appear insincere. Career fields suited to you include actors, arbitrators, beauticians, confectioners, decorators, dressmakers, florists, intermediaries, jewelers, jugglers, lawyers, milliners, negotiators, business partners, salesmen in general, tailors, woodsmen and wig makers.

You may find that at some point you undertake a second, rather different career that has the following characteristics:

You are not afraid of the hard work - you can get in the trenches with coworkers when necessary. Ambition leads to striving to come out on top of every situation. This attitude can make for over-extension of your energy as well as the appearance of ruthlessness. Actually there

is usually an accurate grasp of the situation in nearly every case, accompanied by surprising sympathy toward others. Career fields suited to you include bail bondsmen, brewers, butchers, bill and tax collectors, dentists, detectives, druggists, doctors, embalmers, executioners, funeral directors, insurance salesmen, junk dealers, laboratory technicians, lumberjacks, magicians, pharmacists, paleontologists, psychiatrists, psychics, radiobiologists, radiotherapists, researchers, nuclear scientists, sorcerers, surgeons and tyrants.

Additional factors that influence career direction and abilities you can apply in the job world include the following:

Like the mountain goat, you tend to make slow but consistent progress through life. If you become too one-sided in your thinking, use your intellect to consider alternative positions.

For most people there is one area of the life, not necessarily associated with work, that influences the career strongly. There may be skills developed there that can be directly applied to the career. Also, it may influence the choices you make in where and how to pursue your career.

You find career mentors in your immediate work environment who can be most helpful in your advancement path. You grasp the changes in your career field easily and are able to follow them.

Sloppy thinking will only lead to sloppy pursuit of objectives. One quality of mind is its changeability; you can lose focus if your mind is not well-trained and practiced. You are usually in a state of being ready to take action, coupled with a strong intuitive sense of what direction to take with your life. Controlled by a well-trained mind, intuition can indeed provide equilibrium in your life, as you can foresee conditions and events clearly. When you are out of control, emotional imbalances result and change runs your life, instead of the other way around. The more out of balance you seem, the more your ego-consciousness is ignoring some significant portion of the psyche and its messages. Whatever psychic awareness you bring to your career is a felt thing, not the result of thought. You may find that your thought processes are sometimes inconsistent and self-awareness depends on listening to your "gut". Power is often outside your conscious control. You find it is governed by unconscious drives for the most part. You develop a disciplined will through other channels.

Your Best Work Environment

The question this chapter revolves around is this: How do you maximize your potential, fulfill your higher mission, satisfy your daemon, obtain the money you need to live, enjoy your life, enhance your moral growth, all within the confines of the natural talents you possess, in such a way that at the end of your life, you are satisfied - personally satisfied - that you did well?

Concrete knowledge does not stop at the scientific definitions of things, nor is it limited to the scientific approach to understanding the relationships between people and things. It also includes a felt sense, an inner awareness of the right relationships between things. You can employ concrete knowledge in the mediation between personality and soul, between physical life and higher consciousness. Only through fusion of these apparently separate facets of your being can you approach true knowledge. You tend to seek concrete knowledge through the unfolding of spiritual consciousness. Mature self-consciousness includes awareness of these two appearances and how they interweave to produce what we call life. In your daily activities you may seldom think of this profound reality of existence; as you grow in conscience you develop an affinity for sensitizing yourself to your higher mission.
